Jargon: Terms specific to a certain field;

Metaphor: A means to compare two elements (Can also be big-picture if an entire story or scene is laid out to show a parallel with something else)

Repetition: Using the same words or phrases in a short amount of time for emphasis

Rhyme: When the same sounds appear in two or more words

The Elements of Style: Stylistics in Literature

A narrative, story or tale is any account of a series of related events or experiences, whether nonfictional (memoir, biography, news report, documentary, travelogue, etc.) or fictional (fairy tale, fable, legend, thriller, novel, etc.).
